THE STARTING PLACE



The Starting Place began as a dream of Heartline midwives, Tara Livesay and Beth (KJ) Johnson. While investing in families in Haiti through the Heartline Maternity Center, they sought a way to expand their impact on maternal healthcare in a safe and replicable way. The result of their shared passion was The Starting Place. While The Starting Place Manual has been in use since 2019, the grand opening of the Starting Place as a physical maternity center in Temple, Texas was held in June 2021. By the end of the year, we had welcomed 5 babies into the world and provided maternal education to mothers and children by employing the model of the Heartline Maternity Center in Port au Prince, Haiti.

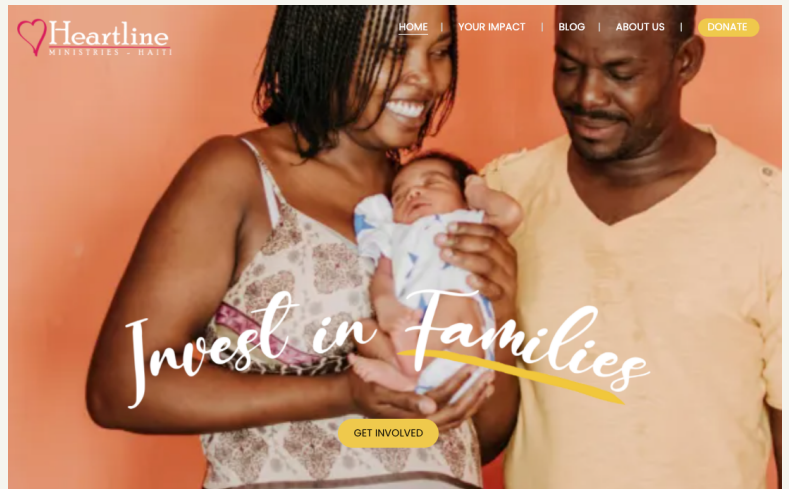
EXPANDING THE EDUCATION CENTER



We celebrated the grand opening of the expansion of the Heartline Education Center in the Fall of 2021. Initially intended for other uses, the building was reimaged with the help of local architects and laborers and now houses classrooms and offices that will be used for sewing, advanced sewing, future offerings in plumbing, and electrical and administrative offices. This expansion will also free up additional space at the main Education Center building! In Q1 of 2022, we welcomed almost 300 students to the Education Center! What started with just a few treadle sewing machines has become a large-scale, government credentialed adult education community - changing lives through skills training!

A NEW WEBSITE

Another exciting new arrival in 2021, we launched a new website! Heartlineministries.org received a complete overhaul. A fresh look, new features and easy navigation are just a few of the changes we brought to the new design. Heartline's website serves as a source of information, the home to our blog, and much more.



FANMI ANSANM

In 2021, we formalized our name and program for recurring donors. Fanmi Ansanm, Haitian Creole for `Family Together` is made up of a generous, faithful group of Heartline donors who give monthly to pour into the work of Heartline as together, we invest in families through Heartline programs. Recurring donors make up approximately 9% of Heartline's total donor base!

Economic Empowerment

The garment industry is Haiti's largest formal employer, providing 55,000+ jobs! Textiles represent 80% of Haiti's exports.

An income of just \$35/mo. is the determining factor between orphanhood and family preservation.

297 women and men are enrolled at the Heartline Education Center learning life-changing skills!

You make skills training possible for 297 adult students!

Community Outreach

Prolonged pre-trial detention: 82% of Haitians in prison are detained without access to representation or even proof of guilt.

The Heartline Community Outreach Team visits **1000's** of prisoners weekly bringing food and a message of hope.

Maternal Healthcare



Simply giving birth in Haiti puts a woman at risk. She has a 1:80 chance of dying due to pregnancy or childbirth-related complications.

In the United States, that risk is just 1:3,800.

In 2021, we celebrated **125** healthy births through Heartline programs.

You welcomed 125 babies into the world!

Children's Education

Education is fundamental to change. It's estimated that enrollment in school, which is not free in Haiti, hovers near 60% with even lower numbers attending secondary programs.

All **79** children in Heartline's sponsor program receive a quality education, meals, uniforms, annual check-ups, and new in 2022 - scholarship opportunities for advanced studies in university or trade programs!

In 2021, we served **50** different families in their time of need by assisting with food, housing, medicine, transportation, tuition, and more as a result of your generosity.



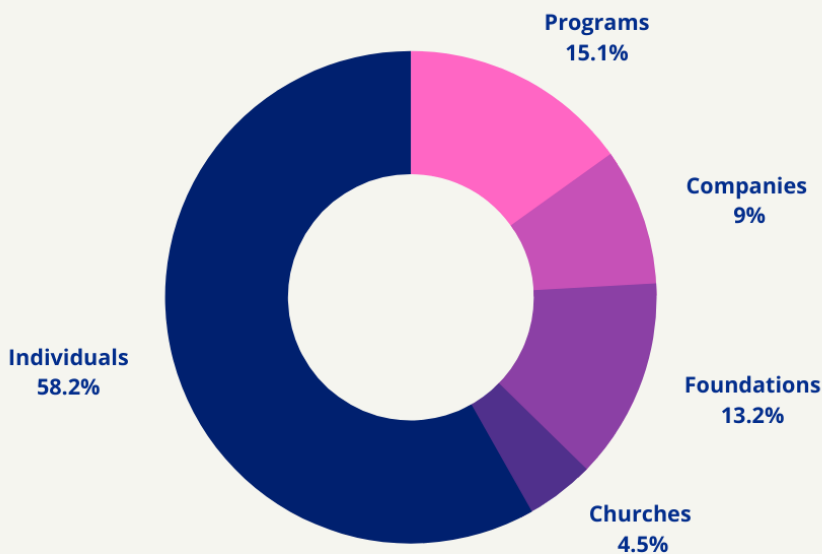

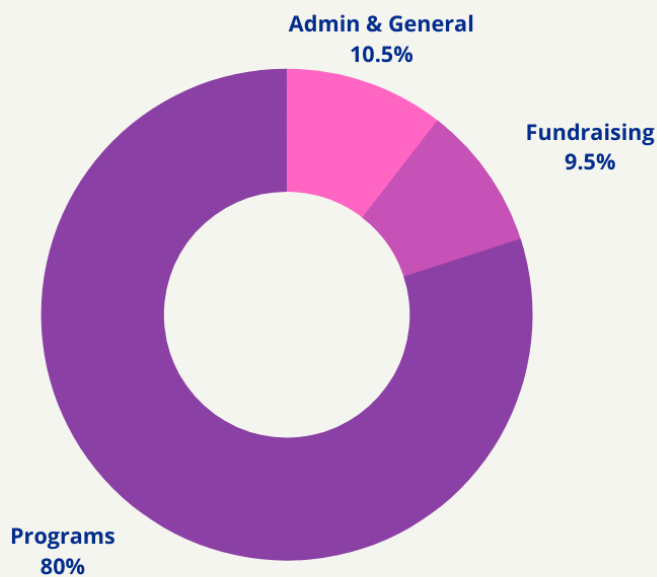
